What's the difference between "in time" and "on time"?

In time

The difference between “on time” and “in time” is a subtle one, and the two expressions may sometimes be used interchangeably. Nevertheless, they express two slightly different ideas:

in time = early enough; not late

on time = punctually; according to the schedule

They are often interchangeable when the implied meaning is “not too late”. Either variant is possible in

The road is closed. I won't be able to get to work in time / on time.

When you say that you “cannot get there in time”, the implied meaning is that you are going to be late, and when you “cannot be there on time”, the implied meaning is that you are going to miss the scheduled start of your working day, which is essentially the same thing.

Doing something "in time" means doing it before a deadline, or doing it before it becomes unavailable:

I wanted to do some kind of study abroad program, but I didn't get my applications done in time.

Oh no; it's already 9:55. Are we going to be able to make it in time?

If you make a mistake with choosing "on time" or "in time", it's not a big problem. Other English speakers might notice your mistake, but they probably won't get upset about it.

On time

- Doing something "on time" means meeting an appointment, or meeting a time that has been set by someone. For example:
 - *I hardly ever get to work on time.*
 - *My flight's on time, so I'll meet you at the airport at 3:30.*
 - *If you don't turn it in on time, you'll receive a 20-point deduction*
- On the other hand, when punctuality with respect to some specific time is required, "on time" sounds more natural:
 - *The meeting has been scheduled for 3 pm. Please, arrive on time.*
 - Of course, it is probably fine to arrive at 2:55, but the point is that you should be present in the correct conference room at 3 o'clock.
 - When it is the fact that you are not (too) late that matters, "in time" is the more natural variant; in fact, you can still be "in time" even when you are not "on time":
 - *I didn't arrive at the cinema on time, but I still arrived in time to see the whole film.*

• Here are 16 English grammar mistakes Indians commonly make:

Incorrect: Myself I am Suresh babu.

Correct: I am Suresh babu.

While introducing oneself, it is usually observed that the users mix up both the possessive pronoun 'myself' and the subject pronoun 'I'.

Incorrect: I am having four brothers and three sisters.

Correct: I have four brothers and three sisters.

Present continuous tense cannot be used for pragmatic situations such as this. Simple present tense should be used.

Incorrect: He do not have a laptop.

Correct: He does not have a laptop.

Do not should not be used after the subject pronoun (He, She, It).

Incorrect: Does she has a car?

Correct: Does she have a car?

The helping verb does is used at the beginning and the main verb have denotes possession or ownership.

Incorrect: (Question) "Today office is there?" (Answer) "No office is not there. Today is Bharat bandh."

Correct: (Question) "Is today a working day?" OR "Are we working today?" (Answer) "Yes we are working today or no we are not working today."

Incorrect: That only, she is very arrogant.

Correct: That was what I said. She is very arrogant.

Saying "That only" was the wrong way to emphasize what the speaker has already said.

- **ncorrect:** Last before year she got very good marks. **Correct:** Year before last she got good marks.
- Phrases that can be used: Month before last, Day before last, Week before last.

- **Correct:** He did not write the test last week.
- The helping verb 'did' is followed by the present tense of the verb and not the past tense form.

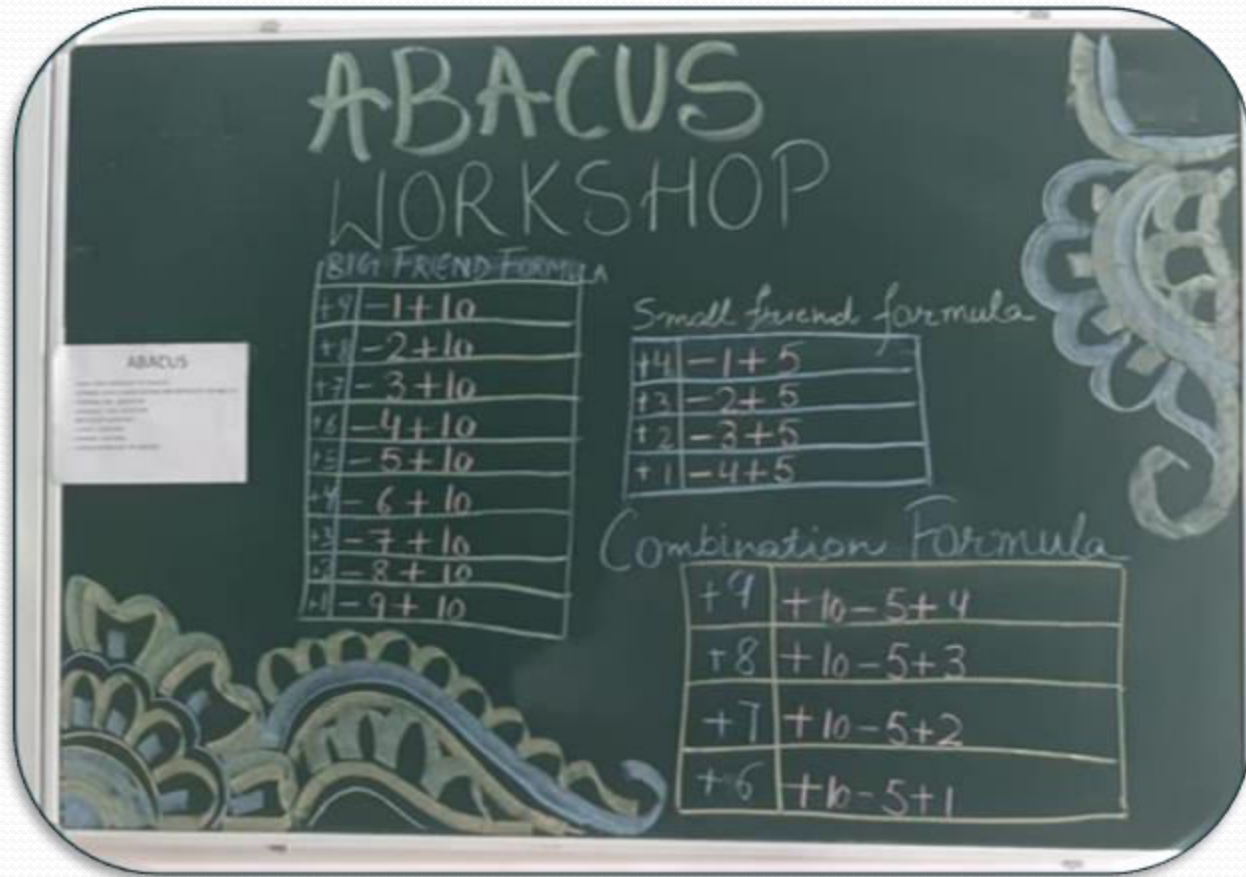

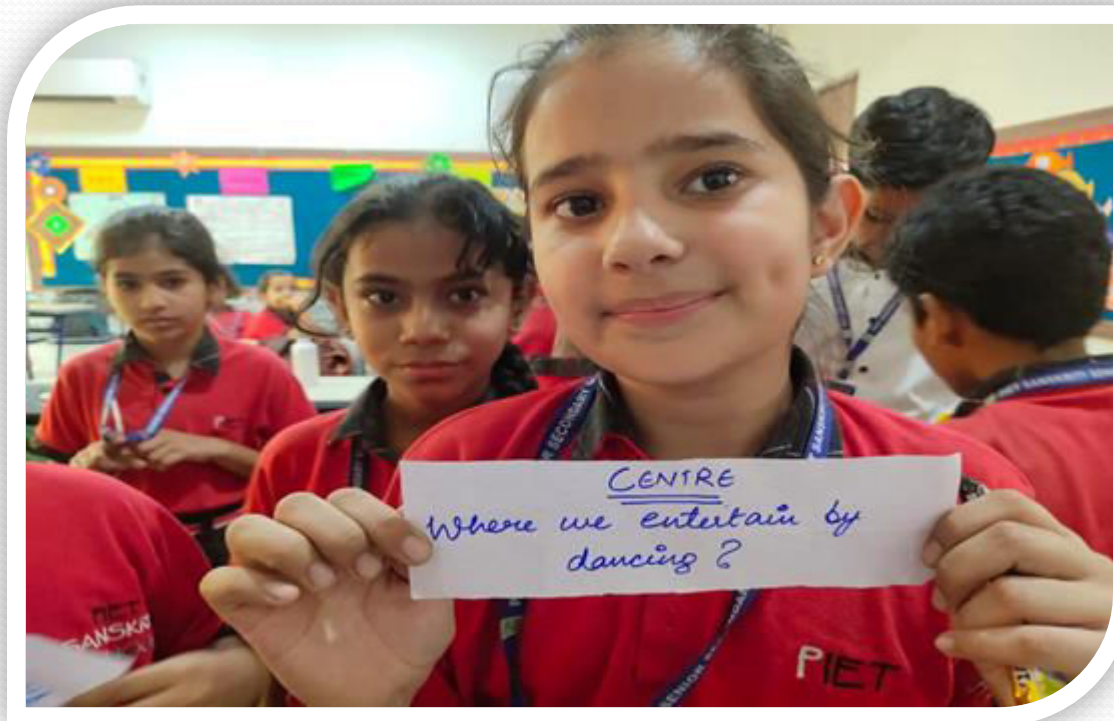

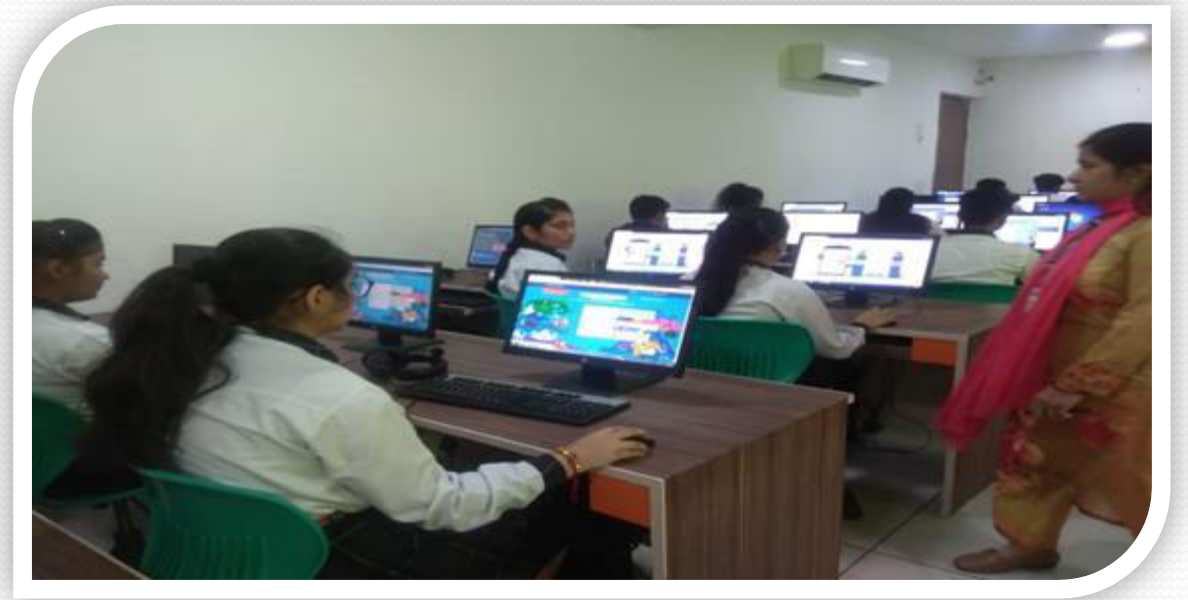
